Job Summary

The Contemporary Worship Team Lead, in partnership with the senior pastor, provides leadership and vision for weekend worship services and special event music ministry, primarily in the Great Hall. The Contemporary Worship Team Lead focuses on equipping and empowering others for their ministry, and so recruits, trains, deploys, and supports musicians and singers who help lead the congregation in worship. Calvary's music ministry should reflect and deepen the three dimensions of Calvary's vision: Up, In, and Out. The Contemporary Worship Team Lead partners with other staff and volunteer music leaders for special music events, as appropriate. The Contemporary Worship Team Lead must be a follower of Christ and have a living faith, and be able to inspire others to a life of discipleship and mission.

Qualifications

The lead needs to be proficient on one or more instruments, be able to lead others vocally, and help other leaders sing in tune and lead spiritually and musically to inspire the congregation to express their praise to God.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Recruit, train, deploy, and support others to lead in music ministry
- Oversee music for weekend worship in the Great Hall
- Partner with the Family Life Team Lead and the Youth Team Lead to include children and youth in music ministry, where appropriate
- Collaborate with other staff and ministry leaders in the planning of additional/special services and events
- Develop and utilize a related ministry budget
- Participate in staff meetings, staff prayer, staff development, and team-building
